What will I do at school?



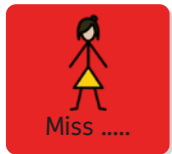
Every day begins with phonics or reading, and everyone has maths and literacy each day. Other subjects include science, geography and history.

... and lots more



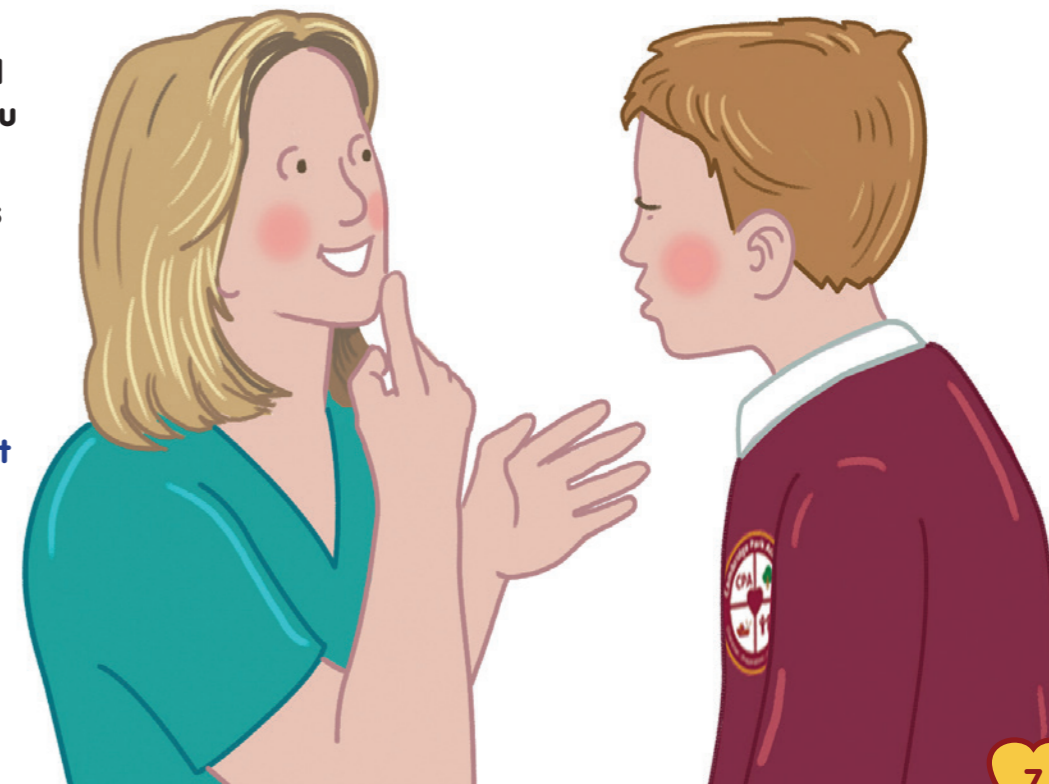
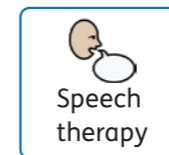
What extra help will I get at school?

If you need to, you can spend time with our special therapists, who will help you to develop.

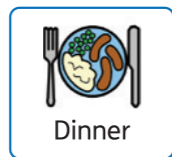
Our specialist professionals include:
