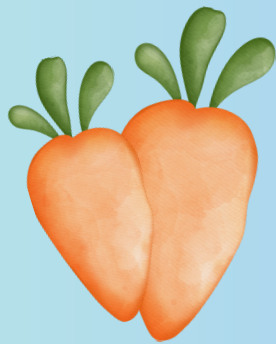

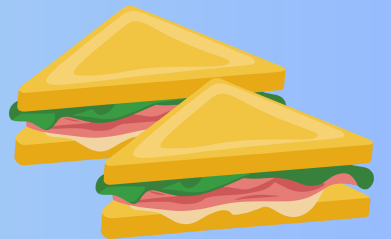

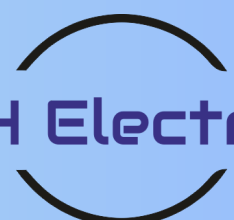

We are working to support our community further with warm clothing parcels. These are for single adult households and family households who are struggling in these cold winter months that are receiving energy support through our service.



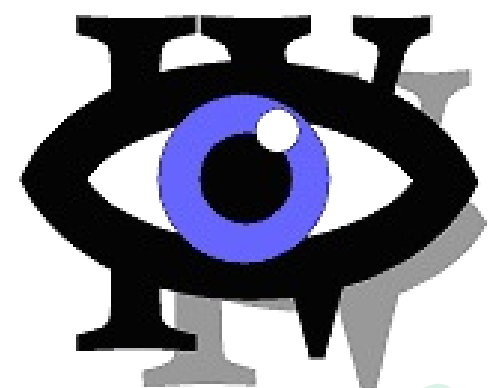

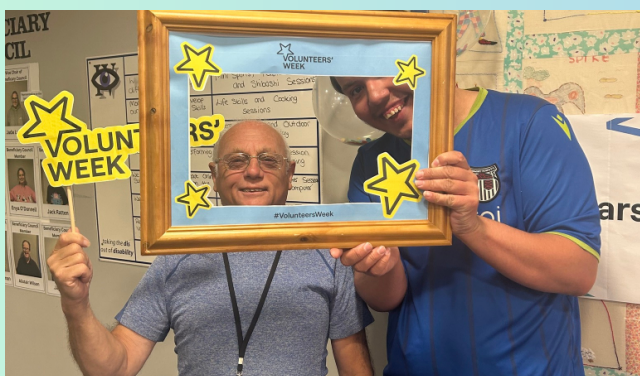
